- Protect/ transplant existing native trees on site wherever possible.
- Take steps to safeguard endangered & vulnerable species of flora & fauna existing on the project site
- Minimize negative human impacts on natural resources such as air, water, and vegetation. Rehabilitate or restore ecosystems within our project boundary.
- Incorporate green spaces, such as parks, gardens, plantations into our developments to enhance biodiversity, promote habitats, and improve the overall ecosystem.
- Monitor, review & communicate biodiversity performance through relevant indicators for continuous improvement
- Provide appropriate resources to adequately manage biodiversity at our sites
- Engage with local communities, NGOs, employees and other stakeholders to participate in biodiversity conservation efforts and raise awareness.
